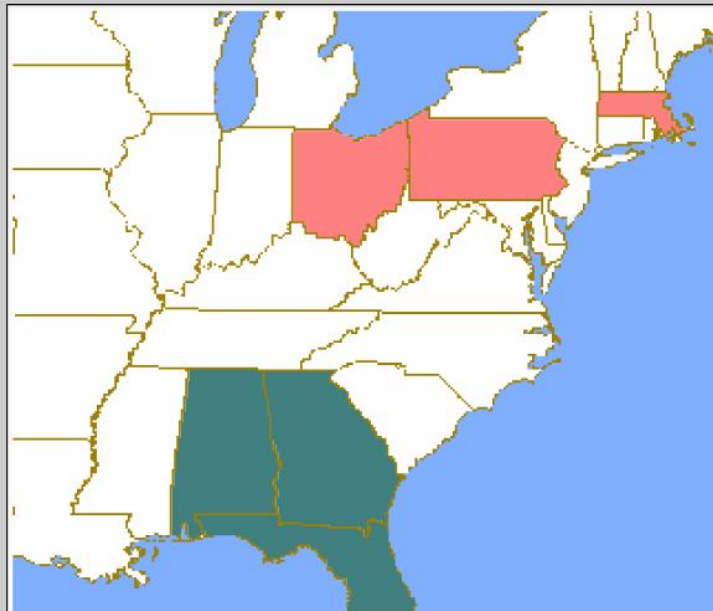

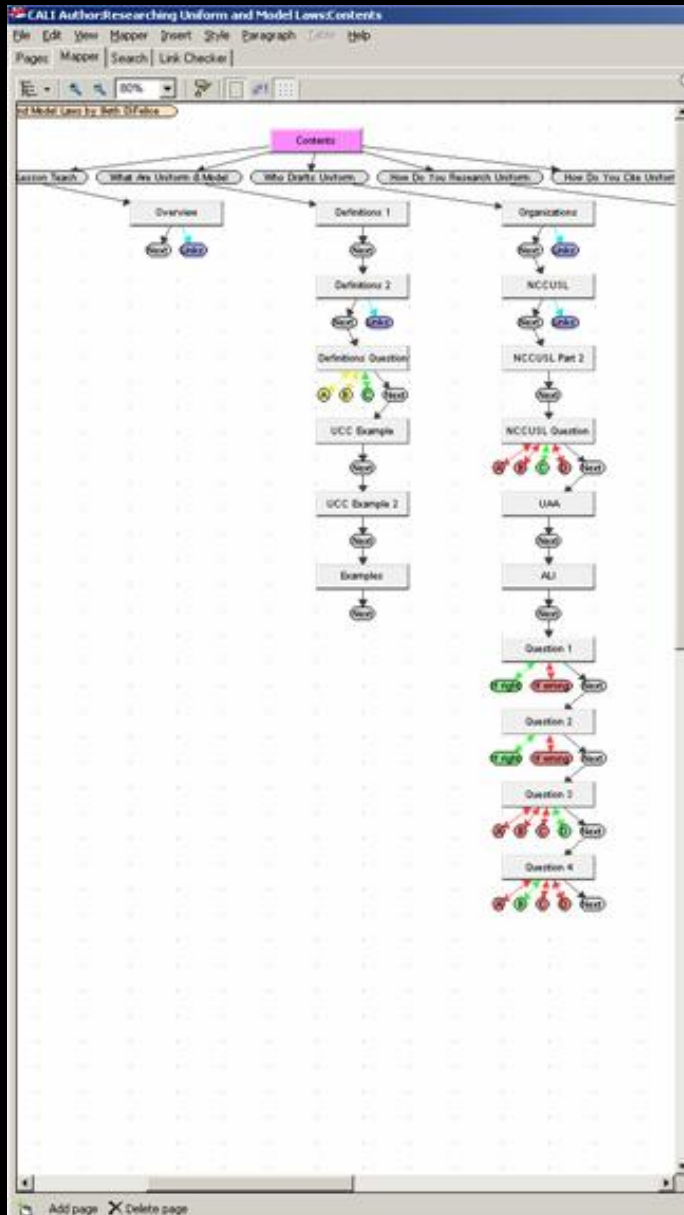
1872: Allen & Wheeler first uses the mark "Tea Rose" on flour.
