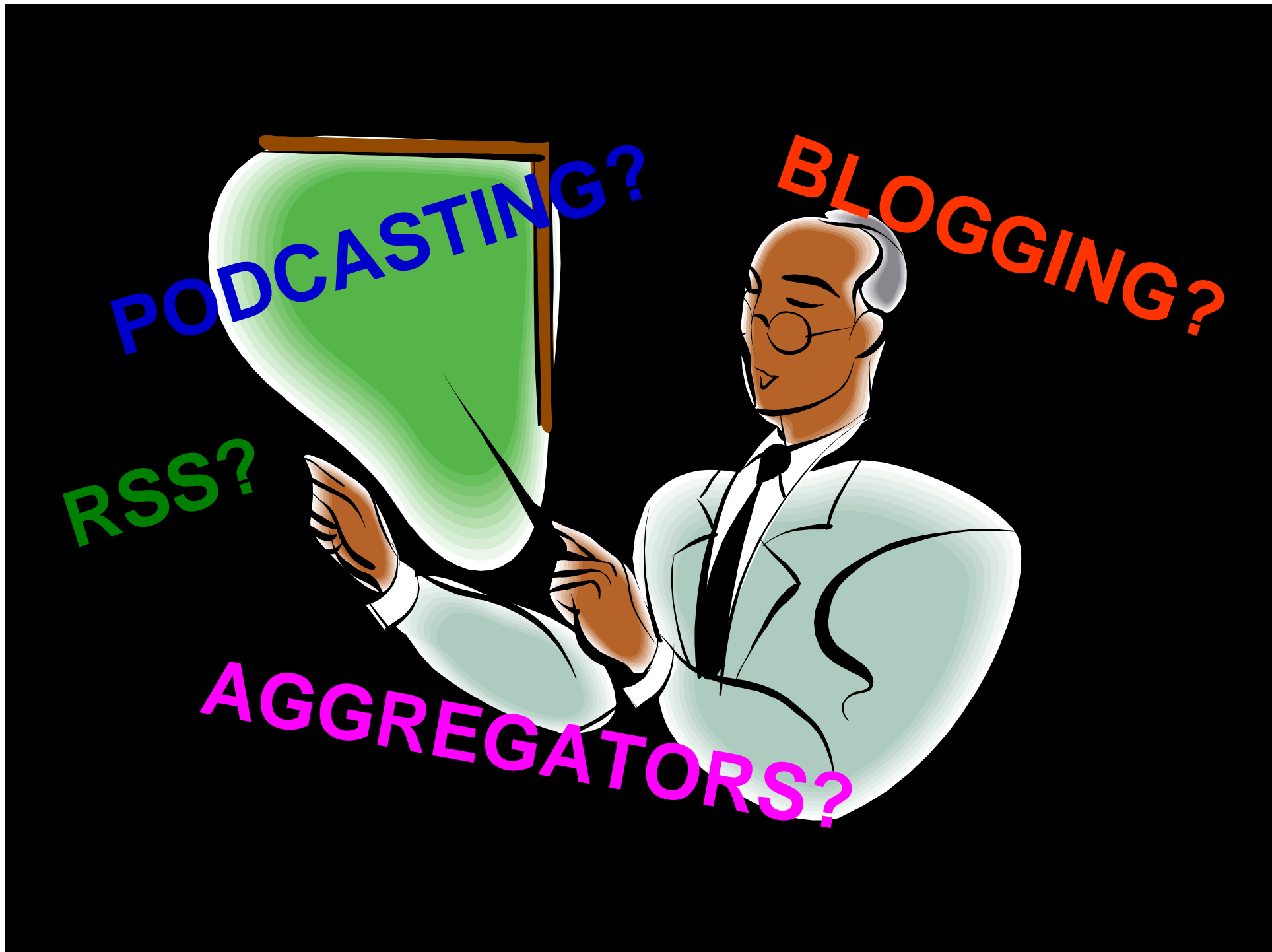

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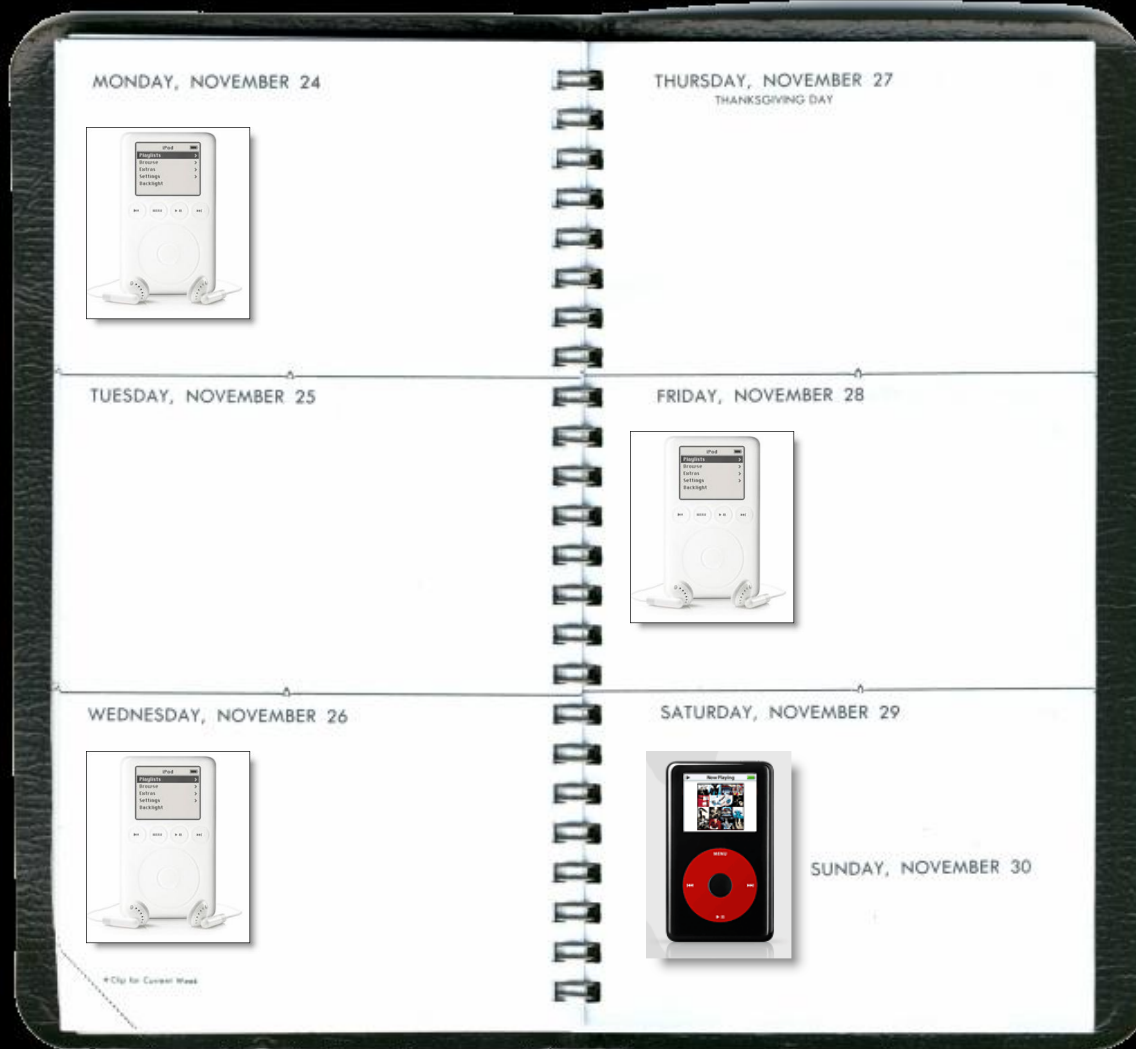

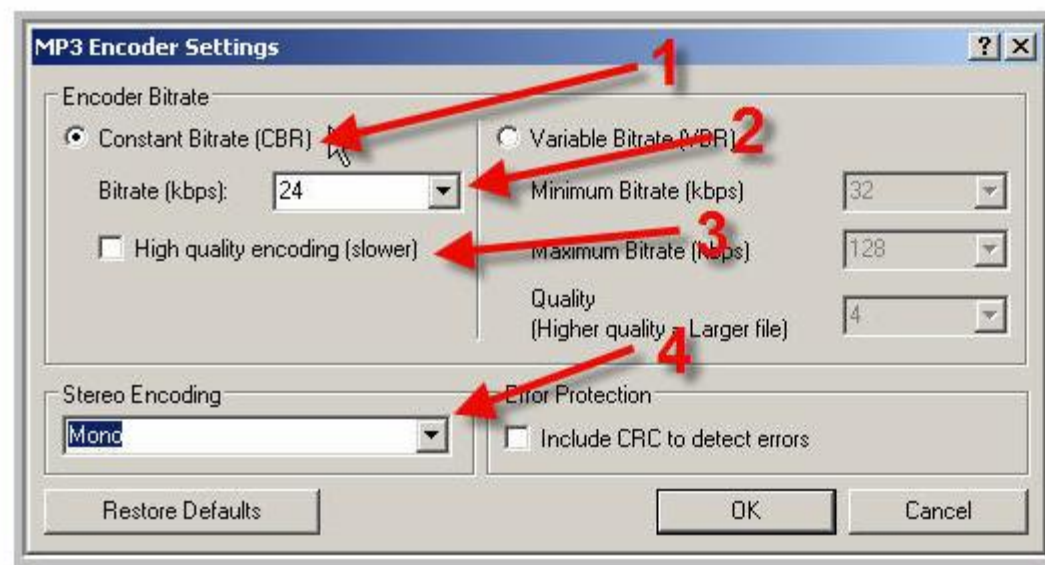

Make sure that the Output Format is set to **.mp3** and that the Output Folder is set to **C:\Documents** 'Encoder Settings' button.



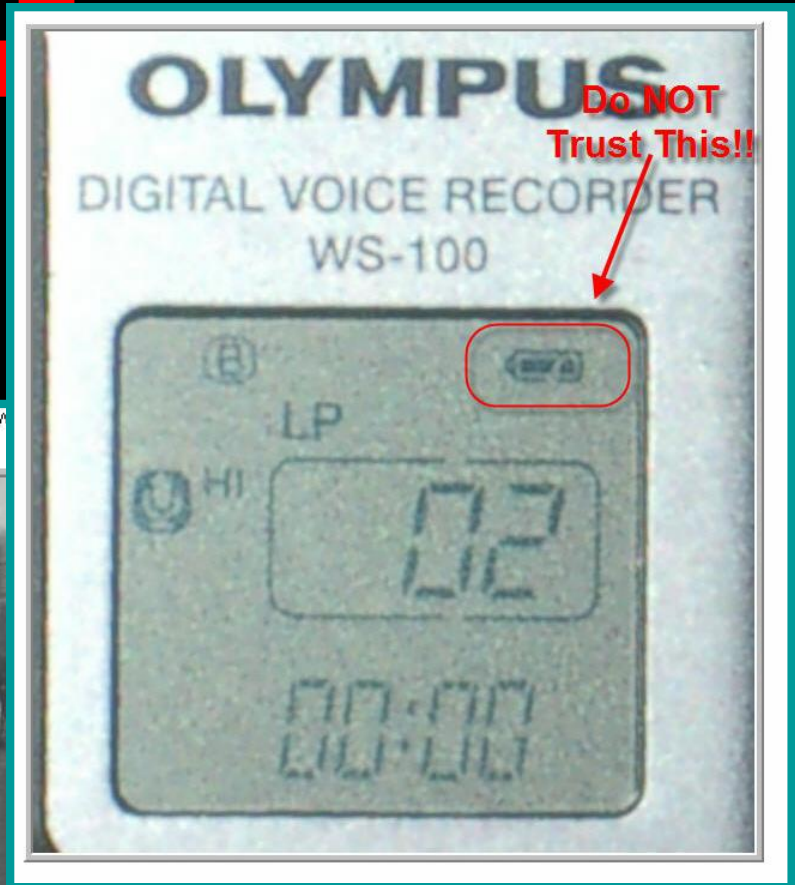
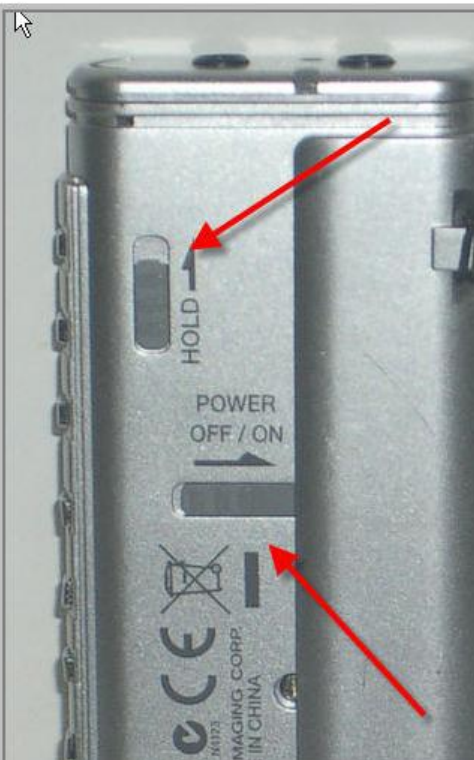
- 1) The Constant Bit Rate (CBR) should be checked.

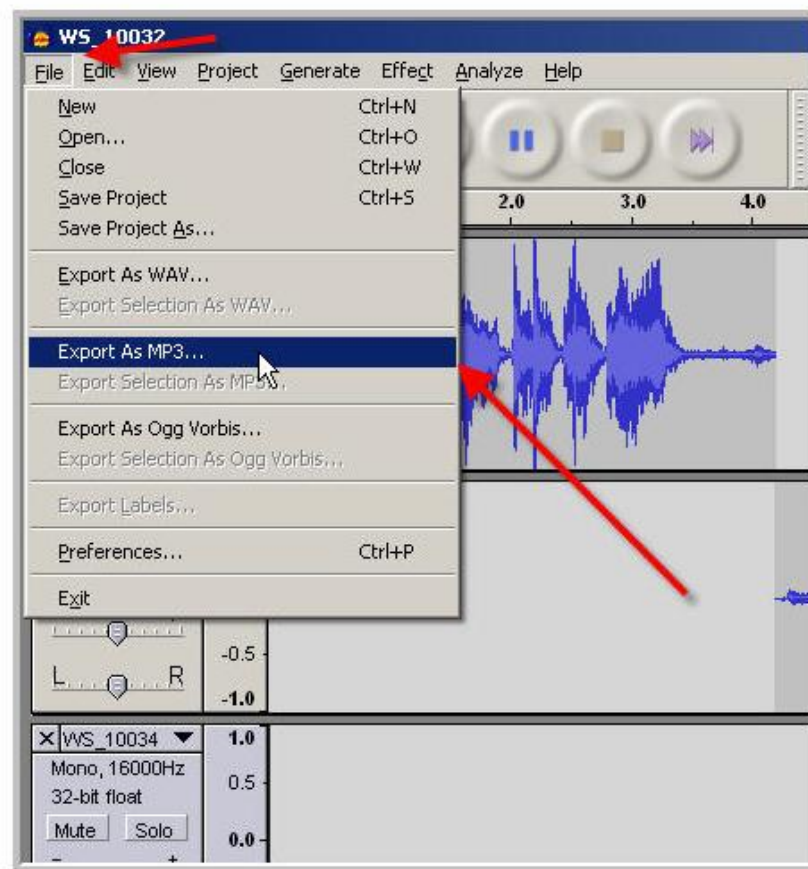


2) The Power button (also on back) turns the V

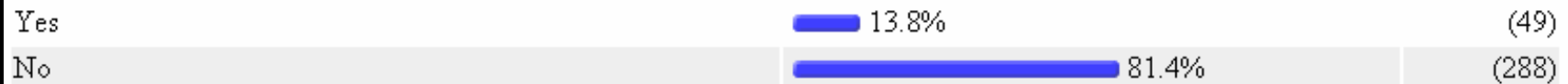

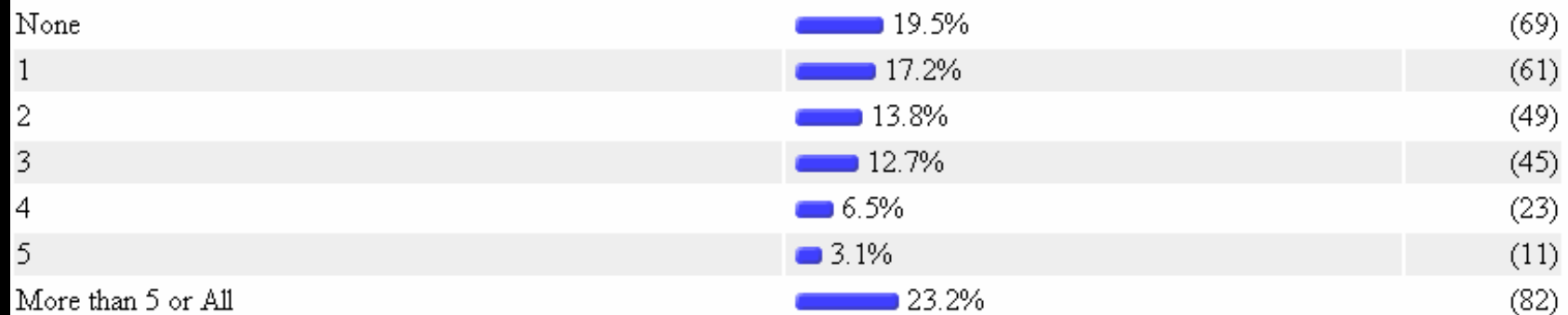
**5. Prior to this course, have you ever listened to a podcast?**



**6. Did you know that your instructor is either podcasting the classroom lectures or creating podcast summaries?**

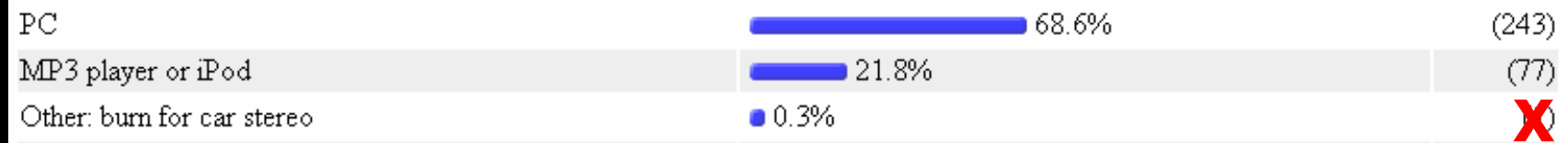


**7. How many of the podcasts have you listened to?**

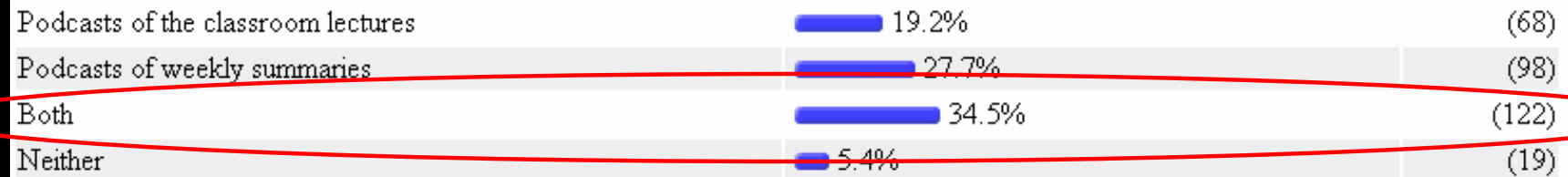
